St. Luke's Memorial Garden

Everyone wants to have peace about end-of-life plans, including a final resting place. But many of us haven't thought about a plan, or we're in denial about the need for a plan, or we just don't know what to do. We understand that this conversation may be hard, but we now have a beautiful solution. The Memorial Garden at St. Luke's is planning an expansion, so if you consider St. Luke's your church home during your journey, perhaps choosing it as your final resting place at journey's end is the answer.

ABOUT THE EXPANSION

Created in 1998, the original garden features 557 niches (now all sold) and memorial walkway stones for those who are interred elsewhere. The expansion will offer 758 niches with 246 floor niches (identical to the niches in the existing garden) and 512 wall niches which will be stacked six high. The new section of the Memorial Garden will be located between the existing Memorial Garden and the Fellowship Walk.

PRICING

The granite marker with incising and future maintenance is included in the price of your niche. Price

\$4,500

Memorial Walkway Stone with incising and future maintenance.

\$1,500

A pre-construction agreement guarantees your space in the Memorial Garden. Once the site plan has been finalized, you will be contacted to sign your contract and choose your niche or walkway stone. We anticipate construction to begin later this year, dependent upon pre-construction sales.
